

## Aim

This five-day course will provide participants with the skills and knowledge to perform the role of safety observer for vegetation management work near live powerlines.

## Required For

Persons performing the role of safety observer for vegetation management work near live powerlines.

## Entry Requirements

Nominated persons must have successfully completed the Energy Safety WA online course of instruction for the Code of Practice for Personnel Electrical Safety for Vegetation Work Near Overhead Powerlines.

## Relationship to Training Package

The course aligns to several units from the Energy Skills Australia UET12 Transmission, Distribution and Rail Sector Training Package Qualification UET20312 Certificate II in ESI – Powerline Vegetation Control.

## Details

**Code:** ESSTR0023

**Duration:** 5 days

**Course No:** Maximum 10 participants

**Fee:** \$2,060.00 per participant GST free

**Payment:** Clients will be invoiced prior to the course. Payment is required before the course starts unless other arrangements have been agreed to with Energy Skills Solutions.

- Identify hazards associated with vegetation management work near live powerlines
- Comply with sustainability, environmental and incidental response policies and procedures for vegetation management work
- Plan effectively for the removal of vegetation near live powerlines
- Demonstrate the effective monitoring of vegetation management work near live powerlines

## Content

- UEENEEE101A Apply Occupational Health Safety regulations, codes and practices in the workplace
- UETTDREL13A Comply with sustainability, environmental and incidental response policies and procedures
- UETTDREL14A Working safely near live electrical apparatus as a non-electrical worker
- UETTDTRVC23A Plan the removal of vegetation up to vegetation exclusion zone near live electrical apparatus
- UETTDTRVC27A Monitor safety compliance of vegetation control work in an ESI environment
- UETTDRRF03B Perform EWP rescue

## Delivery

The course is conducted face-to-face in a training room environment.

Learning activities are included in the course to ensure knowledge and skills can be safely applied to workplace situations.

The importance of safety is emphasised throughout the course.

## Assessment

A knowledge assessment for each unit is included in the course.

Participants are issued an on-the-job workbook at the completion of the course.

The workbook is used to collect and present evidence for assessment. The completed workbook is submitted to Energy Skills Solutions for assessment and sign off.

Participants will need to achieve both the off the job training and on-the-job assessment requirements to successfully complete the course



## Certification

The units in the course are nationally recognised.

A Statement of Attainment is issued after the participant has successfully completed both the off the job and the on-the-job components of the course.

The statement will list those units that have been completed in the workbook.
